

- 12 Praise God for the success of our summer Bible camps in volatile North Ossetia, Russia!
- 13 Continue praying for our brothers and sisters in Central Asia as they faithfully proclaim the gospel in the midst of escalating religious persecution.

- 22 Please pray for courage and safety for our brothers and sisters in Russia who are standing firm in their faith, even in the midst of mounting religious persecution.
- 23 Pray for the leaders of CWW in Pinsk, Belarus as they go on a retreat this month to recharge and prepare for the 2019-2020 SWW program.
- 24 Pray for our SWW leaders in Mongolia as they expand their ministry efforts to reach as many of their

- 25 Please pray that God would use SWW leaders in Israel to share the Messiah's love with His lost sheep all across the Holy Land.
