**1** Praise God for the thousands of children and youth throughout Eurasia who are experiencing the love of Jesus during this year's neighborhood Bible day camps!

**2** Continue praying that God would bring an end to the ongoing conflict in eastern Ukraine, where Ukrainian soldiers are still being killed, and thousands of people remain trapped in the war zone with little access to food, water, electricity, and heat.

**3** Please pray for Timothy, one of our School Without Walls (SWW) coordinators in Kazakhstan, who is recovering from a severe case of COVID-19.

**4** Pray for our national SWW coordinators throughout Eurasia as they participate in a Zoom training conference today.

**5** Pray for SWW leaders across Moldova as they host several neighborhood Bible day camps for at-risk children and youth this month.

**6** Please pray for our SWW leaders in Armenia as they host small-scale outreach events for children in their communities amid challenging social-distancing restrictions.

**7** Pray for the presidential election in Belarus, which is taking place this month. There is a lot of tension in this nation, so please pray that God's will would be done.

**8** Pray for the Karachay-Cherkessia region in Russia's North Caucasus, where SWW leaders are serving amid a recent outbreak of COVID-19.

**9** Please pray for SWW leaders in Israel as they organize and lead neighborhood Bible day camps and other events for children and youth in their communities.

**10** Pray for a special neighborhood Bible camp for children from war-torn eastern Ukraine, which SWW leaders are hosting on August 10-15.

**11** Praise God that Missionary Church in Gomel, Belarus is starting to resume in-person services, which adhere to social-distancing guidelines!

**12** Please pray for a special neighborhood Bible day camp in Moldova, during which our partners from ShareWord Global in Canada will help lead Bible lessons through Zoom.

**13** Pray for Church Without Walls (CWW) in Pinsk, Belarus as they work with local authorities to plan an outreach that will take place on their city's main street.

**14** Pray for SWW leaders in Siberia, Russia as they bring the Good News of Jesus to unreached people groups throughout this remote region.

**15** Please pray for a Next Generation Professional Leaders Initiative (NGPLI) webinar for Christian businessmen and women that we are hosting today.

**16** Despite the challenges caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, CWW in Pinsk, Belarus is still growing their small group ministry, so please pray that God would bless these efforts.

**17** Pray that God would protect SWW leaders in eastern Ukraine as they distribute copies of our special Good News Prayer Guide (Molitvoslov) in the war zone on August 17-19.

**18** Please pray for Aleksey, our SWW coordinator in Kazakhstan, as he and his wife Alysa move to Almaty, where they will provide legal help for persecuted churches in the city.

**19** Pray for wisdom for Ukraine's government leaders as they decide whether to open schools in September. This decision will impact the work of the International Alliance for the Development of Christian Education (IADCE) in Ukraine.

**20** Praise God for His provision for our SWW leaders in Russia's North Caucasus during the COVID-19 pandemic!

**21** Please pray for a 7-Day Generosity Challenge conference that we are hosting in Donbas, Ukraine on August 21-22.

**22** As Missionary Church in Gomel, Belarus resumes in-person services, pray that God would grow their home group ministry and evangelistic efforts.

**23** Please pray for Aleksey, our SWW coordinator in Kazakhstan, as his wife Alysa, his mother Larisa, and his sister Irina are all experiencing health issues.

**24** Continue praying for our brothers and sisters in Central Asia, where religious persecution is rapidly escalating.

**25** Praise God for the recording studio we are opening at our office in Irpin, Ukraine this month! This studio will be used to record webinars and interviews, and to host livestream training events.

**26** Pray that God would provide for the needs of Aleksandr, our SWW coordinator in Russia's North Caucasus, and his family.

**27** Please pray for SWW leaders in Mongolia as they develop new ministry strategies to share the gospel with their unreached neighbors in the nation's most remote regions.

**28** Pray for an upcoming baptism training event that is taking place at CWW in Pinsk, Belarus.

**29** Pray for Igor, our SWW coordinator in Moldova, as he and his family are building a new house, where they hope to host ministry events and reach young people for Christ.

**30** Please pray for SWW leaders in Russia's North Caucasus as they finish up this year's summer ministry events and prepare for the start of the school year.

**31** Pray for our SWW coordinators, teachers, and leaders throughout Eurasia and Israel as we launch the 2020-2021 SWW program in September.
