11 Praise God for sustaining our intercultural team in Russia's Omsk region during the challenging season produced by COVID-19!

16 Pray for SWW leaders in Mongolia as they continue developing new ministry strategies to reach their nation's most remote people groups for Christ.

17 Pray that God would continue growing our Family as Mission ministry in Ukraine.

18 Please pray for our SWW coordinators in Moldova as they identify new teachers and leaders that will help to strengthen the ministry's impact.

19 Pray for our SWW coordinators and leaders in Israel as they share the Good News of the Messiah with God's chosen people.

20 Pray for our SWW leaders in Perm, Russia as they continue sharing the gospel with unreached people in this remote region.

22 Continue praying for believers in Russia as they hold fast to Christ amid rapidly escalating persecution.

23 Pray for SWW leaders throughout Central Asia as they faithfully advance God's Kingdom in the face of religious persecution.

24 Please pray for our regional and national SWW coordinators as they participate in a special webinar on generosity and fundraising that is taking place today.

25 Praise God for the children and youth who put their faith in Jesus during our neighborhood Bible day camps in Russia's North Caucasus! Now, these young people are continuing to grow in faith as they read

God's Word and talk with our SWW leaders.

26 Pray for the IADCE team as they determine how best to share their training resources with Christian teachers in Ukraine amid the limitations caused by COVID-19.

27 Please pray for our SWW leaders in Belarus and Moldova's Transnistria region as they care for the great physical and spiritual needs of their neighbors who are living in extreme poverty.

28 Pray for our SWW coordinators in Russia's North Caucasus as they launch new SWW groups in Kabardino-Balkaria and Karachay-Cherkessia.
