He soon realized that he no longer "fit in" with his old friends. "One by one, they walked out of my life," said Artem, who now serves in youth ministry and his church's worship team.

"Thanks to SWW, I realized the importance of ministry, and I recognized that God was calling me to get more involved in my church," he said. "My new life's goal is to reach others in my community for Christ."

PRAYER GUIDE

April | 2021



"Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words." Romans 8:26

1 Pray for upcoming Easter celebrations and related Mission Eurasia outreach efforts in our churches throughout Eurasia. Pray these events will draw more people to Christ.

2 More of our leaders and church partners are beginning preparations for summer outreach activities. Pray for more School Without Walls (SWW) students and non-Christian children and teens, many who will hear the gospel for the first time.

3 Pray for the continued health and safety of our Mission Eurasia staff and families. Quarantine measures have been eased in some countries and we are able to go back to some offline activities and conferences in Eurasia.

4 Pray for a youth mini-conference in Khorezm, Uzbekistan, that we are participating in today. Also, our team is leading an “Art of Renewal” retreat today in Khujand, Tajikistan.

5 Praise the Lord for completion of final adjustments and corrections on the Russian-language website, “Faith and Science in the Classroom.”

6 At the end of this month, we’ll host a web-conference with Rob Rienow. He and his wife Amy founded Visionary Family Ministries, which helps families live for Christ.

7 Pray for church leaders and other ministry partners in Eurasia who are struggling to provide for their families. Some are working multiple jobs and need your prayers for strength, wisdom, and direction.

8 Please pray for wisdom in how to best conduct our annual “Leaders in Christian Education” conference, scheduled for the end of April in Ukraine.

9 We will host a youth conference in Talas, Kyrgyzstan this month, but the event schedule has not been released yet.

10 Please pray for the opening of the borders of Mongolia in May, even though it remains unclear what the requirements will be. Pray we are able to hold a training conference in western Mongolia in May and children’s camp in June.

11 Pray for a youth mini-conference that we are offering on leadership and youth ministry

development in Rishon LeZion, Israel.

12 New opportunities in Uzbekistan are arising and we want to hold a few meetings there for SWW students. Please pray for these plans to be successful.

13 Pray for our church ministries in St. Petersburg, Russia. We are making some changes in how we minister to children and are developing small Bible study groups.

14 One of our pastors in the Volga region of Russia recently shared that his son planned to have surgery to remove a tumor. Please pray for complete healing and for the doctors.

15 Pray for ongoing relief efforts among the thousands of refugees in Armenia who continue to rebuild their lives following the conflict that erupted last year between Armenia and Azerbaijan.

16 We’re hosting a missions conference, “Mission 2021,” in Yekaterinburg, Russia, on April 16-19. Please pray for this event and for Mission Eurasia’s Pavel Tokarchuk who will participate.

17 Pray for Light to the World Church in Grodno, Belarus, to be able to continue recording podcasts for Mission Eurasia. Pray for the regional conference that the church will host April 17 and that more baptisms would be reported this year.

18 Pray for a youth conference today that is focused on missions and ministry in Tashkent, Uzbekistan.

19 Please continue to pray for the bakery ministries in Armenia that are opening their doors to provide bread and Scripture to the poor.

20 Pray for one of our SWW leaders, Rashid, in Perm, Russia. He continues to recover from a serious infection he got following an operation. Pray the infection would heal and that his strength would return.

21 Pray for ongoing political turmoil in Belarus and the families of persecuted Christians who continue to share reports of abuse by the government.

22 Continue to pray as we distribute our Good News Prayer Guide (Molitvoslov) to those in need in Eurasia. Pray that God will use these guides to draw more people to Him.

23 Pray for the planning of the missions conference in Yekaterinburg, Russia, where they are expecting 500 participants.

24 Pray for Church Without Walls in Pinsk, Belarus, that they would train more ministers to help spread

God’s Kingdom. Pray their discipleship ministry and small groups would continue to grow.

25 Pray for new teams of evangelists to be formed to take the gospel to people in the remote parts of Siberia and that disciples would be multiplied.

26 Please pray for our fellow Christian brothers and sisters with New Life of Almaty Church in Kazakhstan as they continue their court battle to get back some of their church property from the authorities.

27 Pray the ongoing conflict in eastern Ukraine would end and that more people there would continue to turn their lives over to Christ.

28 Pray for our SWW coordinators and instructors as they pour their hearts and lives into students who seek to serve the Lord.

29 Praise the Lord for the ministry work going on among the Muslim people in the Omsk region of Russia. Please continue to lift this work up in prayer.

30 Pray for Church Without Walls in Pinsk, Belarus. Pray for their youth center and that God would give them vision, needed funding, and wisdom on how to reach the youth of their city for Christ.
