Yevgenia will never forget the five-day “Restart” Christian camp led by School Without Walls (SWW) leaders that stirred her to make the most important decision of her life – the decision to put her trust in Jesus Christ. And she was baptized that week.

“Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.” 1Thessalonians 5:16-18

1 Pray for our SWW teams as they prepare for and launch our summer Bible camps, which are one of our most effective ministry outreaches. Pray for these leaders as they lead creative programs for hurting children and teens and that God will provide the needed resources.

2 Please pray for the construction of a camp site in the country of Georgia. While the team has the land and funding, they continue to confront various challenges involving the government.

3 Pray for our SWW leaders and graduates throughout Eurasia as they complete their classes for the school year, and that graduates have a smooth transition into other areas of ministry in the days ahead.

4 Pray for mini-conference events in Omsk and Tobolsk, Russia and for leaders as they prepare to share the gospel during the Islamic celebration of Eid al-Adha, which will be held in July.

5 Pray for the continued health and safety of our Mission Eurasia staff and families, who still confront quarantine measures in Eurasian countries.

6 Pray for ongoing EMPOWER conference events that are focused on training and equipping effective summer camp leaders for ministry among children and teens throughout Eurasia.

7 Please pray for children's summer camps in Mongolia and the recent opening of their borders. Pray these children's camps will be held in June as planned.

8 Pray for our team of leaders, who are planning a mission trip to the Rostov region in Russia and for their plans to hold a summer camp.

9 Pray as ongoing political tensions and persecution against the church continue throughout Eurasia. Pray that fellow believers in these post-Soviet countries will stay strong in their faith.

10 Pray for the summer Bible camp events being planned in remote, mountainous areas like Buryatia, a Russian republic in eastern Siberia.

11 Please continue to pray for Bread of Life bakeries in Armenia that are opening their doors to provide bread and Scripture to refugees and the poor.

12 Pray for the youth conference, "Christian of

Our Time," that will be held June 12 in Voronezh, Russia.

13 Our SWW team in Rishon LeZion, Israel requests prayer that their youth ministry project would grow, and that the team would be able to rent a house for outreach in June.

14 Pray for the upcoming concert event that the Church Without Walls in Pinsk, Belarus is organizing to raise funds for a child who is ill and needs treatment abroad. Pray the gospel would be shared during this and other upcoming ministry events.

15 Pray for teens in Eurasia as they seek to use their gifts and talents for practical evangelism projects to impact their circle of friends, neighborhoods, and schools for Christ.

16 Pray more young leaders will emerge in churches and home groups throughout the Eurasia region.

17 Pray that teachers and students of Christian schools in the post-Soviet countries we serve would finish well following a difficult school year.

18 Pray for the construction project at Light to the World Church in Grodno, Belarus and for its SWW ministry.

19 Pray that family ministries in Eurasian churches would grow and bring abundant fruit. Pray Christian families would be strengthened, and that non-Christian families would put their trust in Christ.

20 Continue to pray for church leaders in Kazakhstan, where the courts have ruled against Christians and charged them with various crimes. Pray these churches and their ministries will grow.

21 Pray for the health of our leaders and their families as many of them confront spiritual warfare in their churches, communities, and region.

22 Please pray for the youth ministries in local churches in the Perm Province of Russia and the neighboring republic of Udmurtia that took part in our May youth seminar, Fresh Wave.

23 Pray for ongoing relief efforts among the thousands of refugees in Armenia, who continue to rebuild their lives following the conflict that erupted last year over the disputed Nagorno-Karabakh region.

24 Continue to pray for the healing of family members of our SWW leaders throughout Eurasia as there are various health concerns, surgeries, and other related health issues.

25 Please pray for the ongoing war in eastern Ukraine, ministry leaders and partners in the country, and that more people there would continue to turn their lives over to Christ.

26 Pray for the regional youth conference in Belarus that took place at the end of April that drew more than 100 young people who learned to share the gospel with their peers.

27 Praise the Lord for ongoing ministry work among the Muslims in the Omsk region of Russia. Please continue to lift up this ministry work in prayer.

28 Pray for challenging economic and political issues to be solved in Belarus. Pray for our Next Generation leaders there as they share the gospel.

29 Pray various transportation challenges and needed vehicle repairs for our teams in difficult and remote areas of Eurasia will be resolved as a busy summer of travel and ministry fast approaches.

30 Pray for the team in Russia and lead them to people who are willing to start home Bible groups in their communities.
