## Andrey's Story

### January 14-16

### January 17

A family conference called "Moments of Family Worship" will take place for families today in Kremenchug, Ukraine.

A SWW Fresh Wave youth conference will also take place today in Perm, Russia. Russia director Pavel Tokarchuk will participate.

### Transformed By The Grace Of God

"When I was 16, my parents got divorced. After that, my mom and I moved into a small apartment in a bad area. Our neighbors weren't very friendly, and some of them were drug dealers. My mom had to work several jobs to support us, and because she was gone so much, I started spending time with the other young people in our building, many of whom were drug addicts. Soon, I was drinking, smoking marijuana, and using heroin, and before I knew it, I was an addict.

When I was 24, by God's grace, I agreed to start a rehabilitation program. During this program, I put my faith in Christ, and because rehab changed my life, I started working at the rehab center where I received treatment. I have been running the rehab center for nine years and God has set me free from all my addictions.

"After I gave my life to Jesus, I wanted to attend Bible school, and God heard my prayers. Now, I am attending School Without Walls (SWW), and I never miss a lesson. Through this program, God is filling my heart and growing my faith. *Thanks to my teachers and their testimonies, I want to share the gospel with the patients at the rehabilitation center.*"

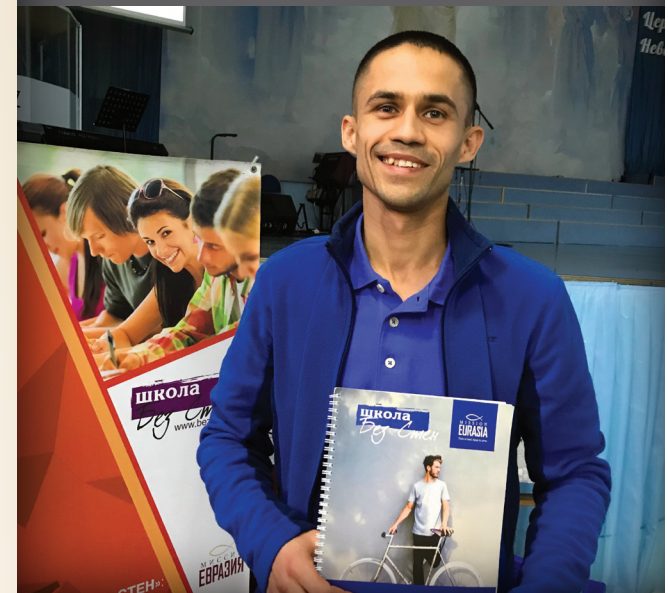

Pray that their move would go smoothly and that they would be able to obtain another car since they will be located 15 miles outside of town.

**21** Please pray for the Art of Renewal seminar taking place today in Dushanbe, Tajikistan. SWW international director Aleksandr Belev will lead the seminar as leaders from different ministries gather together.

**22** Pray for the "Leadership in Challenging Times" youth conference in Dushanbe, Tajikistan, led by Aleksandr Belev and Denis Gorenkov. Pray that this conference would provide encouragement and motivation for participants while teaching them how to minister in the midst of challenges, including pressures from the Muslim community, economic instability, and COVID.
