UPCOMING MINISTRY EVENTS

Raisa's Story

March 5

A youth conference will take place in Transnistria (Moldova). Aleksandr Belev, our SWW international director, will speak to around 200 young people, including some SWW graduates, from Baptist churches in the region.

March 5-7

A leadership conference will take place for Christian teachers in Russia. Around 45 teachers and leaders of associations and groups are expected to attend. This event is part of our Next Generation Professional Leaders Initiative (NGPLI), and Natalia Grishchenko will be leading it. Mission Eurasia will also provide printed resources for participants.

March 18-20

A Next Generation Professional Leaders Initiative (NGPLI) conference will take place in Krasnoyarsk, Russia. Around 70 leaders, many of whom have gone through our SWW program, are expected to attend this conference that we are co-organizing.

March 19

A youth conference called *South Point* will take place in Kherson, Ukraine. We are expecting 300-350 young people to attend. Mission Eurasia is co-sponsoring this conference and will provide speakers as well as printed resources on evangelism and personal and team growth.

March 25-27

A regional youth conference will take place in Salekhard in Russia's Far North. One hundred young people representing various small indigenous people groups, including the Komi, Khanty, Nentsy, and Tselkupy, are expected to attend.

March 26

Mission Eurasia will participate in a training seminar on discipleship in Transnistria (Moldova). We are partnering with the International Sports Coalition, a long-time ministry partner, to provide training for teams that are starting sports ministries in Transnistria. Aleksandr Belev will represent Mission Eurasia and will speak on discipleship.

Date TBD A seminar on street evangelism will take place in Irpin, Ukraine. This seminar has been prepared by our friend and SWW partner, Dmitriy Kaznodiy, who will also present his manual on evangelism that we hope to print soon.

"I am 78-years-old, and I live by myself in the war zone of eastern Ukraine. My husband and I used to live together in our home, but the war in Donbass changed everything.

Now, I am partially deaf and I live alone. My husband isn't able to help me because he was injured during one of the bombings. He now lives with his relatives in a different city and is in need of constant care. I wouldn't have been able to take care of him on my own, and I just can't leave our house, because I have spent so much of my life here. It is very difficult to live alone in the midst of so much devastation, especially when you don't know what will happen tomorrow, and you just hope to see your husband again. These challenges fill my life with unbearable sorrow.


